Scholarship Details:

The Ramiro De La Paz Memorial scholarship will be awarded to two recipients. Two awards of \$1,000 will be distributed \$500 per semester during the first year. Funds will be issued to the student by check on a **reimbursement** basis, provided the student meets and submits all necessary documentation. The scholarship applications are judged by a committee based on the below criteria.



Eligibility:

Applicant must be a high school senior that is a dependent of a current member of Nueces Electric Cooperative. The NEC member must have received electric service from NEC for a minimum of six months as of the scholarship deadline.

Applicant must be attending a recognized and accredited Texas institution of higher education, college, or vocational school.

Applicant must be pursuing a degree or certificate in a field related to the electric utility industry. Approved majors are: accounting, business, computer science, technology, engineering, mapping, safety, administrative, marketing, communications, and human resources. Other majors may be considered as they relate to the electric utility industry. For more information on a qualifying major, please email scholarship@nueceselectric.org.

Applicant will be required to submit a resume which outlines the following:

- Honors/A.P/Dual Credit courses taken and academic honors received in high school
- Average hours of extra curricular activities weekly and/or average hours worked weekly
- School & community-related clubs, activities, or acheivements
- Employer(s), Type of work, & length of employment

Applicant must submit the all documents in the following order: (If submitted via email, documents should be submitted on a single PDF file.)

- 1) Completed application
- 2) Resume
- 3) 1 Letter of Recommendation from an employer, teacher, school administratior, or activity coordinator
- 4) Offical, signed high school transcript
- 5) 2022-2023 FASFA Student Aid Report OR most parent/guardian most recent Federal Income Tax Return (Form 1040, 1040-a, 1040-ez) *Please black out SSN on documents*

Failure to follow eligibility may result in disqualification of applicant.
