At NEC Co-op Energy we love honoring our military members, both active and veterans. One way we extend our gratitude is through our military program.

Veterans and active military receive a \$25 electricity bill credit in the month of May, acknowledging their service. If you have already provided your service information, no need to do it again.

To enroll, provide military verification for the Memorial Day by April 26, 2024. Verification is required once and remains on file, applicable to one active residential membership only. *Any verification received after this date will be credited the following calendar year if the account remains active.*

Safely Power Your Shed

Welcome to Joe's Safety Corner! I'm Joe Electric, your friendly neighborhood advocate for safety and awareness!

Thinking about powering up your barn, shed, or garage? Start by checking your local safety codes, especially since detached garages have stricter guidelines due to their typical contents like vehicles, fuel, and power tools. The designation of your structure by your municipality—be it a garage or a shed—plays a crucial role in how you'll approach the electrification process. Opting for an extension cord as a quick fix? Not the best idea, since these buildings require a dedicated power system, distinct from your home's. It's wise to bring in a professional electrician to tackle the complex wiring, from installing a new breaker box to managing the load and conduit needs. And a pro tip before you start digging for any underground wiring: call your local utility locating service by dialing 811 and consult your electric cooperative for valuable advice, ensuring your project proceeds safely and efficiently.
