## Critical Care Status on an Electric Account NEC Co-op cares!

Texas electricity consumers with a family member on life support or who have a chronic condition for whom an interruption of power could result in a life-thretening condition can apply for chronic condition or critical care statue. This status provides extra notice for potential outages by applying for special status with their provider.
